

Service Animal Vs Emotional Support Know Your Rights



	Service	Emotional Support
Type of Animal?	Dog	Any domesticated animal
Training?	Trained to perform tasks for a specific disability	No training requirements
Identification?	None required	No legitimate IDs or vests available
Access to public spaces?	All spaces including "no pet" spaces	Only pet friendly spaces
Can someone question?	Can ask "Is the animal required because of a disability?" and "What work or task has the animal been trained to perform"	No protections against
Allowed at work?	Yes unless it causes direct risk. Must be requested as a reasonable accommodation	Up to each employer
Rules at school?	Yes	Some schools with IEP. Allowed in dorms with documentation
Housing rules?	Can't be turned down or charged fees	Can't be turned down or charged fees
Public transit rules?	Can't be denied access to public transportation, told to sit elsewhere, told to give advanced notice, or charged a fee.	Can be denied public transportation as any other pet would
Airplane Rules?	Can fly in cabin but might need documentation	Each airlines have their own policies but many don't allow
